Top 7 Problems with bad Installations

Uneven Roof Peak Lights

Bad installers often leave lights uneven on roof peaks, making your home look sloppy at night. To avoid this, ask the installer how they ensure even spacing and check their past work for red flags.

Control Panel in Soffit or Attic

Placing the control panel in hard-to-reach spots like the soffit or attic can be dangerous and cause electrical issues. Always ask where the control panel will be installed. If they suggest these areas, it's a bad sign.

Mismatched Track Colors

Mismatched track colors make the lights stand out in a bad way. Ask the company to match the track color to your home, and check that they have the right color before installation.

Wires Across the Roof

Exposed wires look messy and unprofessional. Make sure the company hides all wiring inside the track system. Ask to see examples of their previous work.

Holes in Gutters

Some installers drill holes in gutters to attach lights, which can cause leaks and damage. Ensure the company uses a track system and avoids drilling into your gutters.

Unequal Power Distribution

Poor electrical work can cause lights to flicker or look dim. This can even be a fire hazard. Make sure the installer has trained technicians to avoid these issues.

Downward or Outward Facing Tracks

Improper installation can cause lights to face downward or outward, ruining the look. Choose a company that customizes tracks for your roof to ensure a smooth, even glow.
